
OLDROYD 'Gtx'Geotextile **Membrane**



Geotextile **cavity drainage** membrane for **basement waterproofing** applications



Description

Oldroyd 'Gtx' is a cavity drainage membrane with a geotextile mesh welded to one side. This mesh filters out 'fines' in the groundwater, preventing them from causing blockages in other areas of the drainage system.

Applications:

Oldroyd 'Gtx' is specifically designed for when waterproofing earth-retaining structures such as basements and retaining walls. It is designed to be applied externally, and is generally used on new-build projects (call our technical department for details of other products used for waterproofing existing basements).

Oldroyd 'Gtx' is used as a secondary drainage layer to protect a primary waterproofing system such as: [1]

- DryBase Vapour Membrane
- Vandex Cemelast
- Vandex BB75E
- Vandex Super

This "dual-layer" approach lessens the stress put on the primary waterproofing system, reducing water ingress caused by possible imperfections in the application of the primary system and/or structural movement.

Application

Oldroyd 'Gtx' is rolled out around the perimeter of the basement in an anticlockwise direction.

It is secured at the top of the basement using Oldroyd Gun Plugs. A perforated land drain surrounded by a singlesized aggregate must be laid at the base of the construction (200mm below internal floor level). The land drain must be laid around the perimeter of the construction and lead to an appropriate discharge point.

Availability

Oldroyd 'Gtx' is available in 2m x 15m rolls (30m2)
