#### **Product Description**

Dryzone® Professional Grade Mould Removal and Prevention Kit is a two part, high volume mould treatment pack that removes mould and protects against further colonisation. Taking a dual action approach allows for rapid cleaning using the Dryzone® Mould Eliminator and longer-term fungicidal protection using the Dryzone® 100 Mould Sanitiser. Both products are effective in their domain allowing a mould infestation to be removed and treated in under 30 minutes with little or no scrubbing required.

#### **Application Information**

Start by removing any loose material from the surface before spraying **Dryzone® Mould Eliminator** liberally onto the affected area. Wearing standard protective gloves and googles are recommended. Pour the required amount of **Dryzone® Mould Eliminator** into 5-litre pressure sprayer included in the kit. Care should be taken to ensure that **Dryzone® Mould Eliminator** does not splash onto household plants or soft furnishings.

Dryzone® Mould Eliminator should start to work straight away. When using the product around a shower or bath you may want to rinse off when the mould is no longer visible. When used on painted surfaces, use the microfibre cloth to dab the surface to remove excess material. Ensure Dryzone® Mould Eliminator has been rinsed or wiped away prior to applying Dryzone® 100 Mould Sanitiser.

Clean the sprayer with cold water then fill with Dryzone® 100 Mould Sanitiser. Apply 1 litre of product per 5 m<sup>2</sup> of surface. The coverage may vary depending on the surface. Take the appropriate precautions as outlined above for the **Dryzone® Mould Eliminator**.


Leave Dryzone® 100 Mould Sanitiser for 1 hour for maximum effect prior to washing off. For best results wipe the area with the microfibre cleaning cloth provided in the kit to remove any remaining spores from the surface. Apply the Dryzone® 100 Mould Sanitiser every 6 months or when mould reappears.

Note: Dryzone® Mould Eliminator may discolour coloured bathroom grout. If this is of concern, carry out a • test application in a small inconspicuous area and leave for 24 hours before carrying out full treatment. Dryzone® 100 Mould Sanitiser can be used in isolation on delicate surfaces affected by mould as well as a pretreatment when a surface is being painted. Testing a small inconspicuous area is recommended before full treatment. Be sure to empty and clean the 5-litre sprayer after use. Neither Dryzone® Mould Eliminator or Dryzone® 100 Mould Sanitiser should be stored in the sprayer.

#### **How the Kit Works**

**DRYZONE® MOULD ELIMINATOR**

Fortunately, the **Dryzone® Professional Grade Mould Removal and Prevention Kit** is here to help. The diagram above shows a close up of a typical mould that commonly affects damp walls and surfaces. Dryzone® Mould Eliminator removes the mould at surface level, whilst Dryzone® 100 Mould Sanitiser penetrates the mould to remove the sub-surface hyphae, which could lead to regrowth.

This material and their containers must be disposed of in a safe way. Do not empty into drains. Do not contaminate ground, waterbodies or watercourses with chemicals. Once the container is empty, rinse out onto the treated surface prior to disposal. The empty container is suitable for recycling.
