NOPE!® CP Cockroach Killer is formulated to kill cockroaches quickly, leaving long-lasting residue to provide ongoing protection. It contains a disinfectant which can kill food poisoning bacteria carried by cockroaches. It is designed for use as part of a cockroach infestation control strategy.

NOPE!® CP Cockroach Killer can be applied directly to hard surfaces and other areas of activity. However, it should not be applied to food contact surfaces.

Application Information

Preparation

When you are experiencing a cockroach infestation, **NOPE!® CP Cockroach Killer** is an important part of a control strategy. Before using **NOPE!® CP Cockroach Killer** spray it is advisable to take the following steps:

- If possible identify the species of cockroach and the areas of the building they are likely to frequent. This will help identify some specific areas for treatment. The most common species are:
 - *German cockroaches* – favour higher temperatures and humidity. Looking behind appliances such as fridges is advised
 - *Oriental cockroaches* – hardier species. In the UK, they can be seen outside
- Cockroaches like heating ducts and boiler rooms of large, centrally heated buildings.
- Check pipes, stoves, and sinks, especially in humid areas such as bathrooms and around laundry appliances
- Any area with food and dark spaces will appeal to cockroaches
- Clean the area. Pay particular attention to removing food and water sources and hiding places.
- Repair unsound surfaces (e.g. broken tiles) and any cracks and gaps sealed with plaster, mastic or other suitable fillers. This will remove places for the cockroaches to take shelter

To ensure a successful treatment with **NOPE!® CP Cockroach Killer** consider the following steps

- Use sticky traps. This is a good way of monitoring the infestation.
- Consider a professional pest control company should the infestation be resilient to a DIY approach.

Apply a small amount of **NOPE!® CP Cockroach Killer** to an inconspicuous test area of each substrate to be treated (e.g. carpet, sofa) before full treatment commences to ensure compatibility with the substrate.

Application

Read the label before treatment. **NOPE!® CP Cockroach Killer** should be sprayed onto hard surfaces and soft furnishings in affected areas. Pay particular attention to areas identified as suitable habitats for cockroaches.

Using the spray bottle provided at a rate of 25 – 50 ml per metre square. A 500 ml pack should cover 10 to 20 m².

Wash hands thoroughly after use. Keep unprotected people and animals away from treated surfaces until they are fully dry.

Remove any pets from the area, only allowing them back when the treated areas have had time to dry and have been fully ventilated. Leave the treatment to dry for a minimum of 3 hours, but preferably overnight, and ensure good ventilation before reintroducing pets.

NOPE!® CP Cockroach Killer is not to be used on human bedding, pet bedding, pet sleeping quarters, or where pets frequently lie – instead these areas should be thoroughly washed with hot water.

NOPE!® CP Cockroach Killer is not to be used on food contact surfaces.

Prevention

Prevention of infestation is the best approach to controlling cockroaches. The following steps are recommended to help with this process:

- Cleaning
 - *Keep all surfaces clean and clear of any food residue*
 - *Sweep up any food debris*
 - *Wash up dirty dishes and utensils*
 - *Regularly empty bins and keep them clean and closed*
 - *Clean regularly areas around refrigerators*
- Repairs
 - *Repair leaks to cut off water sources for cockroaches*
 - *Seal gaps and repair cracks. Pay particular attention to gaps around doors, windows and where pipes and cables enter the building*
