Read the label before treatment. **NOPE!® Spider Killer** can be sprayed directly onto the spider, but can also be sprayed onto the areas frequented by spiders such as: CCTV cameras, under furniture, under sinks and shed corners. Using the spray bottle provided at a rate of 25 – 50 ml per metre square. A 500 ml pack should cover 10 to 20 m².

Wash hands thoroughly after use. Keep unprotected people and animals away from treated surfaces until they are fully dry.

NOPE!® Spider Killer is not to be used on food contact surfaces.
